PIMA ANIMAL CARE CENTER'S ADOPTION SPECIAL TO RUN THROUGH END OF JULY

Tucson, Arizona-Monday, July 21, 2008 – The Pima Animal Care Center, located at 4000 N. Silverbell Road, will continue its adoption special through July 31, 2008. The cost to adopt is only \$40.00 (plus the cost of the license for dogs over 3 months old).

Shelters in Pinal and Santa Cruz Counties also took PACC animals to adopt through their agencies. And, although 75 more animals found home this weekend, the Center is still overflowing with adoptable dogs, cats, puppies and kittens.

“We appreciate the support demonstrated by the community this past weekend with the adoption of 75 animals,” said Kim Janes, Division Manager of the Pima Animal Care Center. “We are, however, continuing to ask for their assistance in not only finding new homes for the animals we currently have in our shelter, but in spreading the word about responsible pet ownership.”

PACC shelter hours are; Monday –Saturday, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Sundays, noon – 4:00 p.m. The shelter is closed on holidays.
