**PIMA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT CANCELS
SATURDAY H1N1 CLINIC**

Tucson, Arizona – October 27, 2009 – The Pima County Health Department is advising residents the H1N1 vaccine clinic scheduled for Saturday, October 31, 2009 has been cancelled. The clinic was scheduled to be held at Tucson Electric Park, 2500 E. Ajo Way, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

It is unknown at this time when the next shipment of vaccine will be received. Health Department staff immunized approximately 2200 individuals at the clinic held Monday, October 26, 2009 and exhausted all of the available vaccine. No clinics will be held on Saturday, October 31 or Monday, November 2, 2009 as a result of the delay in receiving vaccine.

Effective November 3, 2009, in anticipation of the continued limited vaccine supply and unpredictable shipping, the Health Department is modifying the H1N1 clinic schedules to the following:

- Tuesdays from 1:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.
- Thursdays from 1:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.
- Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon
