**PIMA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO HOLD
ON-GOING MMR SHOT CLINICS**

Tucson, Arizona – May 6, 2008 – The Pima County Health Department announced earlier today that a sustained MMR shot clinic begin tomorrow, Wednesday, May 7, 2008. Clinic location is **600 S. Alvernon Way**, and the hours will be Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. At the present time, it is anticipated the clinic will run until the end of May.

Since the first measles case was diagnosed in February 2008, 17 confirmed cases have been identified in Pima County. Suspect cases numbered 87 as of May 6, 2008. With assistance from the Arizona Department of Health Services and CDC staff, 35 suspect cases have been closed as of today, bringing the total of suspect cases still under investigation to 52.

The Health Department is also encouraging health care providers, who do not have documented proof of immunity, to attend these clinics. For more information log onto www.pimahealth.org or call 243-7808.
