### **Immediate Adoption Discounts at Pima Animal Care Center**

**TUCSON, Ariz.** – There are more than two hundred dogs and cats available for adoption at the Pima Animal Care Center and a high volume of animals continue to arrive daily. To encourage adopters to find homes for these animals, PACC is further reducing its rates for all adoptable pets immediately.

Discounted adoption prices are as follows:

- Adult dogs: \$35 plus a \$15 license
- Puppies: \$50
- Adult cats: \$35 (two for the price of one on Mondays and Tuesdays)
- Kittens: \$50
- Adult dogs and cats that have been at the shelter for two weeks or longer: \$15 (includes the license for dogs)
- Puppies and kittens that have been at the shelter for two weeks or longer: \$25

Special-needs animals that may have minor behavioral or medical issues that the new adopter will need to address are also being offered at a discounted rate. Please inquire with shelter staff or volunteers for further information.

All adoptable animals are altered, vaccinated and microchipped, and dogs older than three months are licensed before going to their new homes.

PACC is also looking for volunteers to take animals to offsite adoption venues and for support for its rescue partners who are invaluable in helping sick and injured animals recover and find happy homes.

Pima Animal Care Center, 4000 N. Silverbell Road, is open Monday through Friday noon to 7 p.m., Saturday and Sunday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
