



RABIES ALERT

Recent incidents in and adjacent to Saguaro National Park indicate a potential risk for contact with rabid animals. Rabid animals can be very aggressive (especially rabid foxes, bobcats and skunks) and still carry the disease after death.

- Do not approach, feed or pick up any animals
- Report suspicious, unusual or aggressive animal behavior to a Ranger
- Report the location of any dead animals to a Ranger
- If you are bitten or come in direct contact with saliva, wash the exposed site immediately with soap and water - seek emergency medical treatment and notify a Park Ranger
- Call 911 for ANY emergency
