

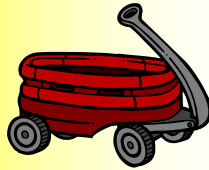
Mosquito problems start at home



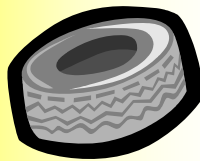
Recycle old bottles, buckets and cans.
