Avoid outside activity from dusk to dawn.



Clean garden ponds, bird baths and fountains twice a week. Treat with larvicide or stock with fish.

Don't give mosquitoes a chance, they need water to breed and grow. Mosquitoes can breed in almost anything that can hold water for a week or longer.

Get rid of places and items that collect water.
